Eligibility and Risk:

Open to all pointing breed dogs in good standing with the A.K.C. A.K.C.-registered dogs must be 6 months of age or over on the event date. I.L.P. dogs are eligible to participate. Bitches in season are **not** eligible and are **not** allowed on the grounds. Dogs are ineligible to enter a test if the Test's Judge or Judges family member has owned, sold, leased, boarded, trained, or handled the dog within one year of the test date. Owners or handlers entering a test do so at their own risk and agree to assume responsibility for any damage caused by them or their dogs. They also agree to abide by the rules of the American Kennel Club and the Regulations for A.K.C. Hunting Tests for Pointing Breeds.

New Illinois State Laws Concerning AKC Licensed Hunting Tests and Field Trials

As of 2004, the state of Illinois requires that all participants in AKC Hunt Test and Field Trials must carry a valid hunting license and habitat stamp. This includes gunners, handlers, and scouts. This law does not apply to Illinois non-residents who wish to participate in any events. The sponsoring club will obtain a waiver of licenses for any non-resident participants.

Hunting licenses are available at Des Plaines on the west grounds through the concession in the building. They are also available through the IDNR web site at:
